- ✓ Video Capture Card or Device
- Webcasting Encoder Software
- Streaming Video / Hosting Package

Simply paste the HTML code into the section of your website you would like to link from and a button link will appear directing guests to a custom page we create for your broadcasts. The broadcasts can be password protected for family privacy purposes. Broadcasts can be archived and uploaded after the live broadcast and made available for on demand viewing for up to 90 days.

Choosing a Provider, What to Expect

NationalWebcasts.com is one of the few providers that is currently providing the latest in webcast technology. Utilizing Flash Media streaming we are capable of broadcasting to nearly any computer system, including all versions of Microsoft Windows operating systems (OS) and browsers, Mac OS, Android mobile devices and more. The type of system your provider uses is the most important part of your webcast system. Most webcast providers rely up Windows Media (.wmv) streaming and while the systems work for some viewers, they generally limit webcasts to Windows computers, unless special software is installed. Most viewers are not comfortable or willing to proceed with these tasks and the families your trying to serve are ultimately left without the ability to connect. With today's growing tablet and mobile phone market, those using Android mobile phones or tablet devices, are simply unable to view at all because they do not support .wmv playback. Ensure you are able to broadcast to everyone, trust in a provider that uses Flash Media Streaming.
